**Oneida City Police responded to a vehicle-pedestrians accident on Main Street just south of Jenkins on 3/1/2010 at 7:45pm. Katherine Schultz 27, Timian Rd. Saquoit was operating a 2005 Suburban north on Main Street when she had a diabetic shock and exited the east side of the roadway striking a pole, a tree and two pedestrians that were walking on the side of the road headed south.
